

Monday Mens Playoffs 2016/2017

The playoff round will begin on February 27, 2016 and same as last year, **ALL teams will make the playoffs!** Team rankings will be determined by points accumulated during Rounds 1 and 2 of the regular square draw play. Teams will be ranked 1 – 9 in each division (A1, A2, B1, B2).

Each division will then be broken down into 3 pools of 3 teams each and play a mini round robin in each pool over the first three week of playoffs (Feb 27, Mar 6, & 13). The top team in each pool per division will advance to the **Championship Round** - 3 teams from A1 & 3 teams from A2 will advance to the A Event Championship, and 3 teams from B1 & 3 teams from B2 will advance to the B Event Championship.

Just a reminder, for those teams qualifying for the **A Event Championship round**, the playoff winning team will represent the **Airdrie Curling Club** in the **2018 Travellers Curling Club Championship**.

The remaining teams (not qualifying for the championship round) will be placed by their pool play ranking in one of two consolation events to be played over the final three weeks of the playoffs (March 20, 27, 28). Once you reach either the Championship round or the Consolation round, if you lose a game, you are out of the playoffs.

Draw to the Button Team Total – At the conclusion of your first pool game, each team will throw 4 stones (each player) to the home end with sweeping and record the measurement (in inches) to the button pin from each stone to determine your **Draw to The Button Team Total**. This total will be used to break any ties with win/loss records at the conclusion of the playoff pool play. Stones covering the pin will be recorded as a 0 inches and stones not coming to rest in the rings will be recorded as 73 inches. Please record your measurements on the form provided and hand in your completed form to **Blair Lenton**.
